# **PBIS & The Golden Spatula**

Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports or PBIS is a nationwide program that improves social, emotional and academic outcomes for all students. This year, FPS implemented a reward system to improve behavior in the cafeteria.

During each lunch period, a staff member monitors behavior for 3 tables. If all the criteria are met (see sample poster), a class will earn a Superstar. Once a class earns 10 Superstars, they are featured on the morning announcements and receive The Golden Spatula! They also receive an extra recess!

In addition to teaching responsibility, this system has greatly reduced the noise & trash levels in the cafeteria.
